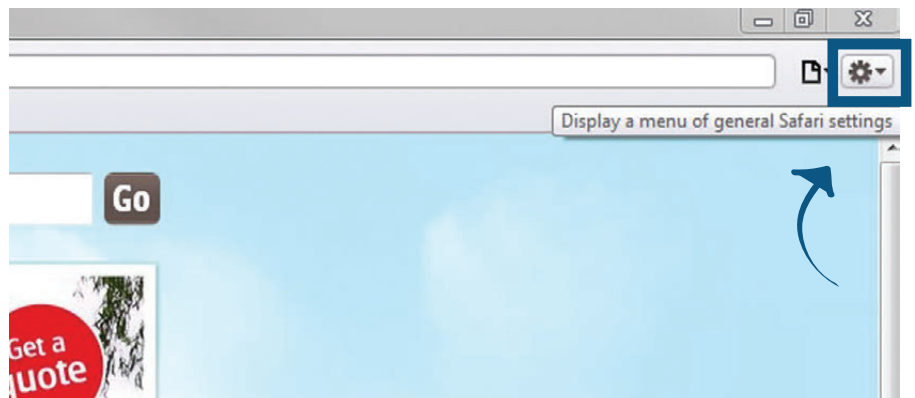


How to disable cookies in Apple Safari

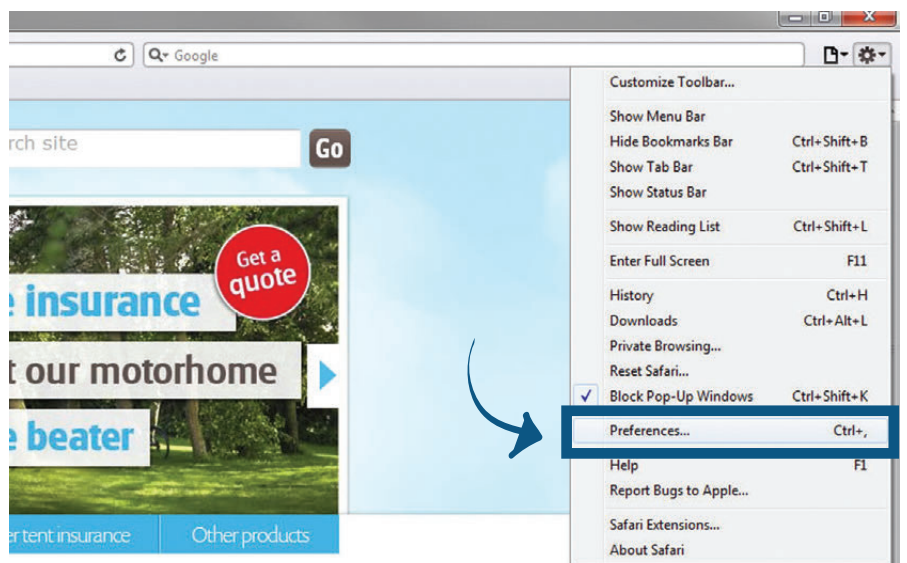
This step-by-step guide will show you how to disable cookies on the Club Care Insurance website (www.clubcareinsurance.co.uk) in Apple Safari.



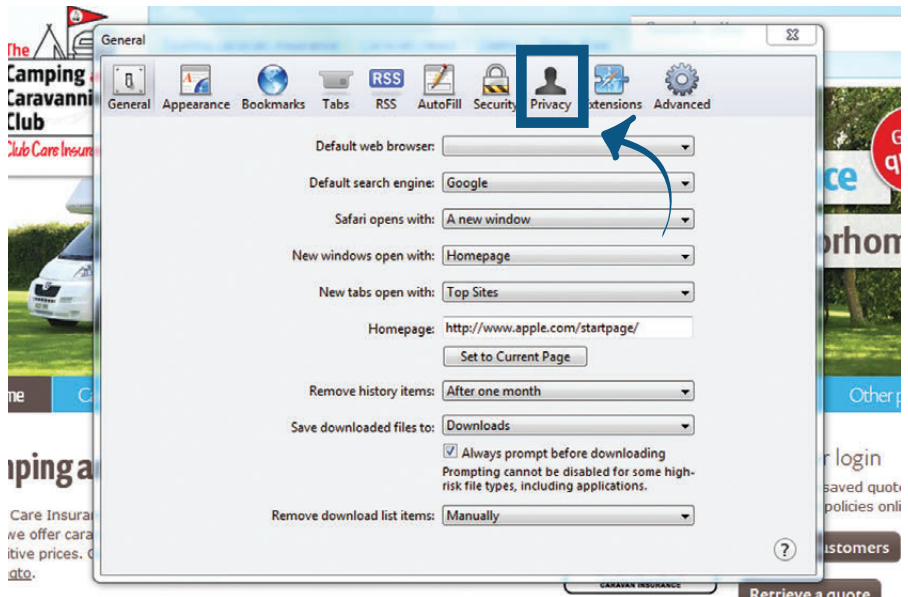
First, click on the general Safari settings option, represented by a small cog in the top-right hand of the screen and highlighted in the diagram.



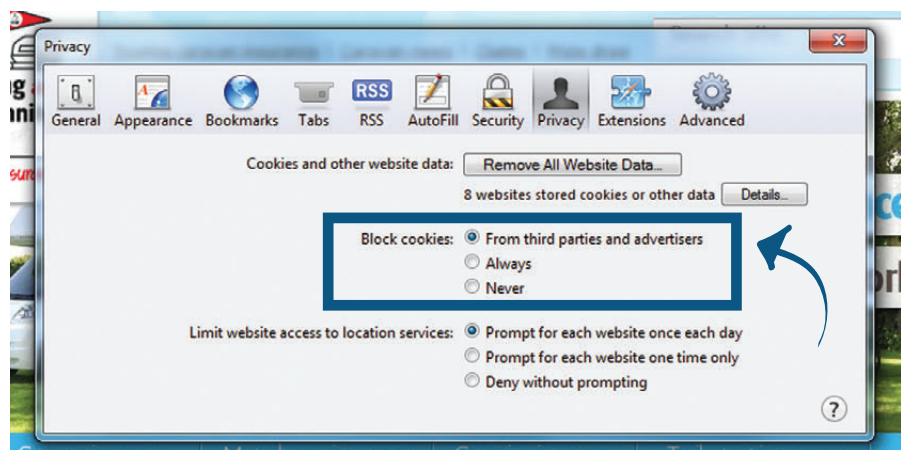
In the drop-down list that appears, select "Preferences...".



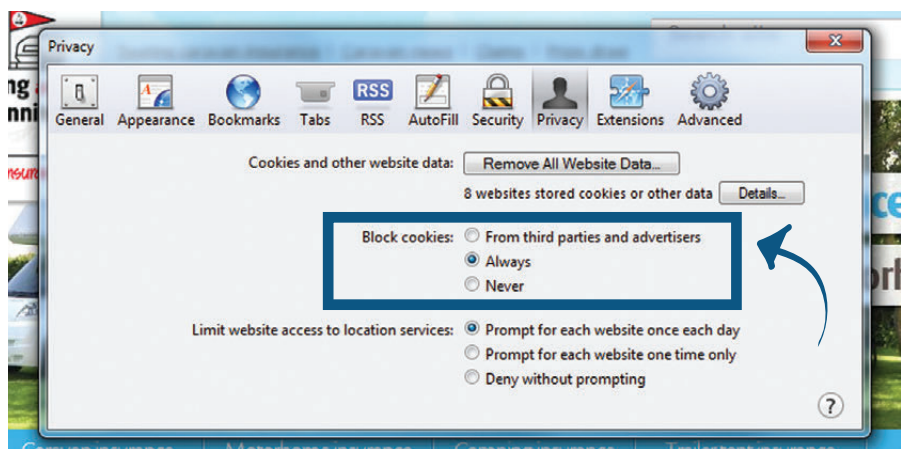
A "General" options pop up box will appear. Select the "Privacy" tab located along the top of the options.



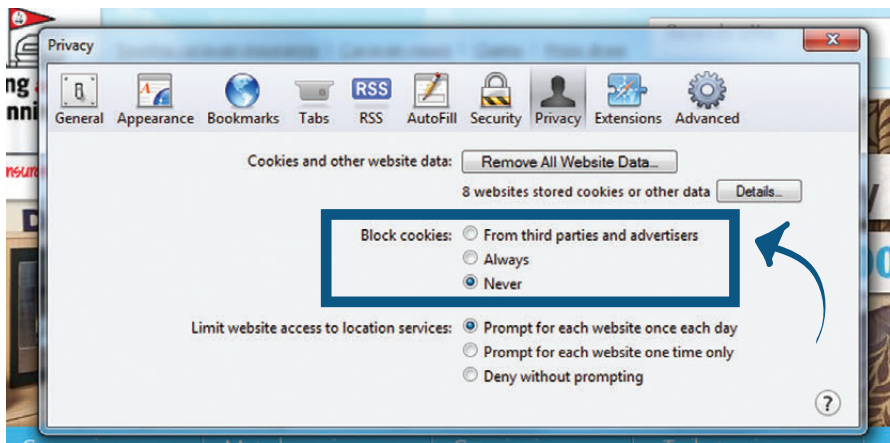
To disable cookies from third parties and advertisers select the relevant option under "Block cookies:" as shown in the diagram.



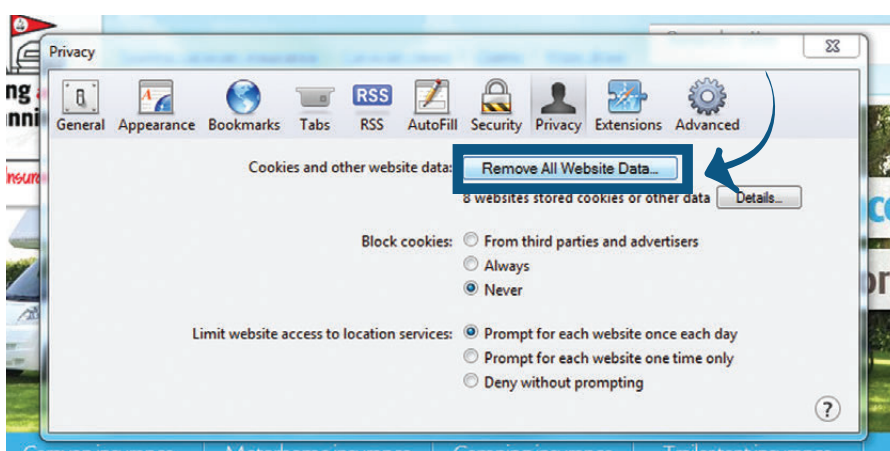
To disable all cookies from any sites you visit select "Always" under "Block cookies:" as shown in the diagram.



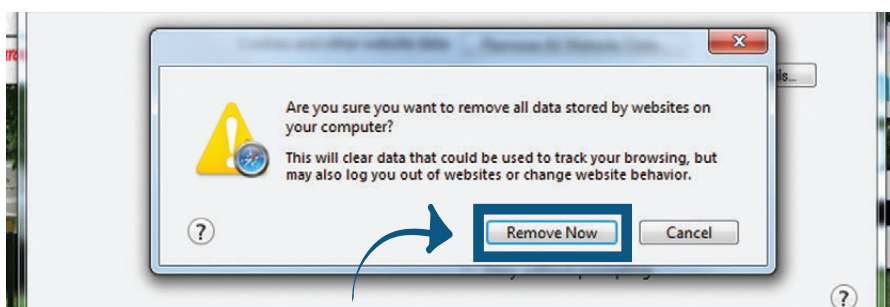
To allow any website to save any form of cookies on your computer select "Never" under "Block cookies:" as shown in the diagram.



You can remove all cookies from any website you have visited by selecting "Remove All Website Data..."



A confirmation menu will then appear. Select "Remove Now" to completely remove all cookies from your browser.



If you're already on the website you may need to refresh the page for the changes to take place. Click on the refresh icon or press F5 on your keyboard.
